- I5 Window N Wall
ILMO Thomas Leonard infant s/o Percy & Gracia BROWNE w.d. on the 7th July 1896.
- I6 Plaque on organ
Restored to the Glory of God and IMO Francis Joseph HUNT w.d. 20th Aug 1982 aged 69y. By Audrey his wife and their son Anthony. Rededicated by the Revd John KIRKHAM MA Bishop of Sherborne 25th Jan 1984.
- I7 Marble Plaque to rear of organ
STTMO the Revd Edward PEACOCK MA formerly Fellow of Trinity College, Cambridge and for a period of 29y the faithful and respected Vicar o.t.p. He d.t.I. on 14th Feb 1848 in the 61st y of his age. His mortal remains are deposited in the same vault with those of his first wife and their son. This tablet is erected by his affectionate wife and children.
- I8 Vestry
Richard NEWMAN of Fifehead parish, Somerset a. 32y. In the vault underneath the ground a leaden coffin and beloved and from the chancel vestery in Oct MDCXCIII leaving one son Richard and two daughters and Barbara now living.
- I9 Plaque
ILMO Sr Richard NEWMAN bart w.d. Dec 30th 1721 and of Dame Frances his wife w.d. Dec 4th 1730. Also of Sir Samuel NEWMAN their son w.d. June 4th 1747. And of Frances & Barbara NEWMAN and Elizabeth KITCHEN three of their daughters w.d. viz. Frances on 27th Aug 1775, Barbara on 6th Jan 1763 and Elizabeth on 26th May 174. Sir Richard & his lady had three other children viz. Richard, Grace & Edmond all of whom died young.
- I10 Plaque
Thomas NEWMANNUS latin inscription Oct 21st MDCIL, Richard NEWMANNUS June 10th MDCLXLIII
- I 11 Plaque on desk
..O Walter Wilks SAWTELL Vicar o t p 1939 - 1947 by his sisters.
- I 12 ...th of altar
.... n adjoining vault are deposited the remains of Anne w/o the Revd Edward PEACOCK MA Vicar o t p. She was the second d/o the Right Revd William Lord MANSEL DD late Lord Bishop of Bristol & Master of Trinity College, Cambridge b. Jan 1792 she d. at Torquay Nov 8th 1832 after a long illness in which she evinced exemplary patience, eminent piety and devout resignation. This tablet is erected to her memory by her affectionate husband who, while he fondly recalls the mild and christianes which adorned her character deeply deplores the loss which he and his children sustained.
- I 13 Marble Plaque
In this place are deposited the mortal remains of the Revd Henry FORESTER MA. He d. April 16th 1819. IMO his many virtues, affection has placed this stone.
- I 14s Plaque on bookcase
dedicated TTMO Beryth FERGUSON SRN 22:6:1920 - 17:6:1990.

IMO William Mansel PEACOCK 2nd son of the Revd Edward PEACOCK vicar o t ? d. Sept 19th 1841 in the 21st year of his age.
